

Student - Statement of Rules

Windswept Music Conference

The following rules were adopted by the Executive Board of the Creative Motion, Alliance, Inc. in November, 1992, and most recently revised in November, 2008. All students and their families, as well as all teachers, are provided with copies of these rules prior to the conference.

Each teacher is responsible for his/her own students' awareness and understanding of these rules.

1. The minimum age of conference attendance will be twelve years by the conference date when accompanied by the teacher or parent. Special consideration may be given to students very close to twelve years of age when accompanied by a parent. No other children under twelve years of age will be permitted to attend conference classes. Minimum age of those students attending the conference without their teacher or parent shall be fifteen years. In the event a teacher or parent is not in attendance an adult sponsor attending the conference must agree to assume responsibility for the student with the approval of the student's parent or legal guardian. High school graduates are considered part of the student body for the conference immediately following their graduation; however they may petition for adult status with the recommendation of their teacher.
2. For the student's protection, we must know their location at all times during the week of the conference. Students will always be accompanied by another workshopper; the buddy system will be firmly enforced. A "Student Monitor" will be appointed for both the boys and the girls. Students are required to check-in with their monitor at every meal and each night when they are back in the dorm. The Student Monitor must know where students are at all times, including the afternoon break. If students leave the dorm for any nonscheduled conference activity on campus, including practicing in the music building or exploring the campus, you must be with a buddy and let your monitor know where you are going!
3. Students are required to be in the dorm between 9:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., unless special permission is obtained from the student monitor and the student's teacher. The dorm will be locked between midnight and 7:00am.
4. Students should be in their own dorm rooms by 11:00pm and remain quiet after 11:15 pm.
5. There is a swimming pool on campus. Students may only swim when accompanied by an adult over 21 and with the consent of their teacher and their Student Monitor.
6. Student cooperation and participation are expected during all conference activities, meals and classes.
7. Students are not permitted in the dorm rooms of the opposite sex. Lounge areas are available for co-ed socializing.
8. Off-campus activities (e.g. shopping) will be allowed with the permission of the student's teacher and student monitor. An adult affiliated with the conference who is over the age of 21 must accompany the student.

9. All workshopers will respect and take care of college property. The Creative Motion Alliance is held financially responsible by the University. for repair and replacement costs . Fines will be assessed for all damages per the terms of our contract with the host organization and responsible parties will make appropriate reparations to the Creative Motion Alliance. All conference participants will adhere to the rules printed in the participant packet. (No damage to property, no alcohol or drugs, no disorderly or lewd conduct, and no open flames.)
10. Failure to comply with the conference rules may result in the students being sent home for the duration of the conference with no refund and at the student's expense. The Rules Committee in consultation with the student's teacher, parent or sponsoring adult will handle all disciplinary measures.
11. The Creative Motion Alliance is a non-profit organization. While we cannot be responsible for accidents or injuries of participants, we are careful to provide safe conditions for our students. Safety rules, including fire and tornado procedures, will be reviewed at the beginning of the workshop.
12. Students will treat all members of the community with respect, including the student monitors.
13. All students must return this statement of rules and the notarized parental consent for medical treatment form on or before registration. *The notarized form is necessary for receiving treatment at the local hospital in the event of a medical emergency.*
